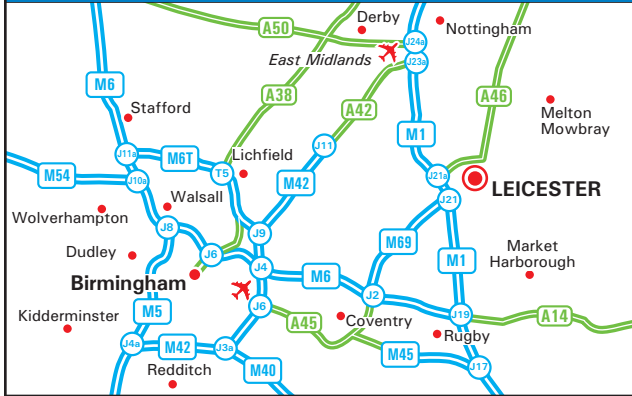

From M1/M69, Junction 21

- Follow road (A563) from motorway roundabout to large roundabout at Fosse Park.
- Take LEFT at roundabout towards Leicester along Narborough Road (A5460).
- Continue along the dual carriageway, over the traffic lights near the Holiday Inn. The road changes into single carriageway and goes under the railway.
- Turn RIGHT into Upperton Road (Signposted to Leicester City football & Leicester Royal Infirmary). "Upperton Road" changes to "Walnut Street" at the roundabout over the river.
- The entrance to the residences' car park is from Filbert Street which is parallel to Walnut Street:-
- Turn RIGHT off Walnut Street into Burnmoor Street, just before the pelican crossing ** (Lucky Supermarket and the newsagent are on the corner of Burnmoor Street).
- After a short distance turn LEFT at the mini-roundabout into the cul-de-sac of Filbert Street and you will see the entrance to the residences' car park in front of you.
- Alternatively, you can turn RIGHT at the traffic lights on the roundabout over the river and take 1st LEFT into Filbert Street (building site and car park on the corner). Continue along Filbert Street and go straight over the mini-roundabout into the residences' car park.

From Aylestone Road (A426)

- Turn LEFT into Walnut Street at the traffic lights opposite the Leicester Tigers rugby ground.
- Turn LEFT into Burnmoor Street just after the pelican crossing
- Follow instructions from ** above.
- Please note - we have a clamping system in operation and you must display a parking permit. Anyone not showing either a numbered permit or a visitor's pass WILL BE CLAMPED. Please refer the parking policy to ensure you only park in designated areas.
